GENERAL TOURNAMENT RULES AND INFORMATION
(Please retain this page for your files.)

1. All Entrants must be a member of a local TSUSBC association, within the jurisdiction of the Tennessee State USBC.
2. Entrants must use their highest Tennessee USBC certified league average. Only averages established through a league certified in Tennessee will be accepted. Averages will be in the following order:
 - a. Highest 2015-2016 winter season for at least 21 games.
 - b. If "a" does not apply, the highest current average as of March 1, 2017 with at least 21 games will be utilized.
 - c. If "a" or "b" does not apply, the highest 2016 summer league average with at least 21 games will be utilized.
 - d. All others will bowl scratch.
 - e. USBC Rules 319a-2, 319d and 319e do not apply in this tournament.
3. The tournament shall consist of a 4-woman team event, a doubles event, a singles event and all events. Three consecutive games shall be bowled in each event. Optional All Events will consist of 9 games total (first appearance in each event.) To enter doubles and singles, you **MUST** enter both events. You will bowl doubles first. The tournament will be handicapped, and will be based on 90% of 210.
4. The 4-member team bowling the highest total pins plus handicap in the team event shall be declared the TSUSBC Women's Team Champions; the 2-member team bowling the highest total pins plus handicap in the doubles event shall be declared the TSUSBC Women's Doubles Champions; the individual bowling the highest total pins plus handicap in the singles event shall be declared the TSUSBC Singles Champion. The individual bowling the highest total pins plus handicap in the 9 game all events shall be declared the TSUSBC All Events Champion.
5. A bowler may enter twice in the team event, providing that at least two bowlers in the line-up are changed. It will be the bowlers' responsibility to make sure the two teams do not have a scheduling conflict. A bowler may enter only once in doubles and singles. EXCEPTION: at the tournament site, a bowler will be allowed to bowl one additional time as a substitute in the doubles event and/or in the team event (provided she has not been entered in the team event twice.) to fill unexpected vacancies. All events will be determined by the bowler's first appearance in each event.
6. **SUBSTITUTES: ARE ALLOWED WHEN A REPLACEMENT IS NECESSARY.** If at all possible, substitutions should be made one hour before scheduled bowling time. In case of an emergency, after a game has started, a substitute shall be allowed in the team and doubles events only. The combined scores are to count in either of these events. If no substitute is available, only the actual score of the frames bowled shall count.
7. The lineup will be the same as shown on the entry form. Pacers will not be allowed.
8. Singles are bowled immediately following doubles. If one bowler is late for the doubles event, the entrant present will bowl her singles event first. If her partner has not arrived by the time the singles event is finished, and a substitute is not available, she will be permitted to bowl her games in the doubles event in order to qualify for all events.
9. **NO FEES SHALL BE REFUNDED**, after entry has been received, dates and times assigned by the tournament director and dates and times are not refused by the team or individual entrant prior to the preparation of the schedule,
10. **Prize Fund:** All prize money will be returned 90% handicap and 10% scratch. The prize list shall be compiled on the basis of at least one in ten ratio in team, singles, doubles and all events. In case of a tie for the championship, co-champions will be declared. Plaques will be awarded to the handicap and scratch champions. **The All Events Scratch Champion shall have her entry paid by the Tennessee State USBC into the US Women's Open Championship.**
11. Bowlers are to check in at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time to bowl. Team captains will check in for their team; doubles partners will check in together. Bowlers without USBC cards may be required to purchase an affiliated membership card at the cost of \$25.
12. Only one bowling ball per bowler will be permitted on the ball return during the tournament competition.
13. No food or drink will be allowed in the bowling area. Cell phones must be turned off or placed in the silent mode during participation.
14. Bowlers are requested to wear suitable attire when participating in the tournament (no short-shorts, miniskirts, t-straps, tank tops, hats, etc.)
15. Teams wishing to bowl together must send entries, fees and a request to bowl together in the same envelope.
16. There will be a \$25 return check charge.
17. USBC rules and regulations will govern this tournament.
