14th Annual “Pee Wee” City Tournament Rules

- 1) All entrants must be members of a bowling league within the jurisdiction of the Memphis Area USBC using bumpers.
- 2) All bowlers will bowl two (2) games with bumpers.
- 3) Bowlers will use their highest league average up to and including October 20, 2014, based on a minimum of six (6) games. Bowlers who do not meet the average requirement will use their current average with at least six (6) games prior to their participation in the tournament. All others will bowl scratch. A copy of the average sheet showing first and last name of all bowlers with total pins, number of games and averages as of October 20, 2014 **MUST** accompany the entry form.
- 4) Bowlers may bowl on more than one (1) team as long as the teammate is different each time. Bowlers will bowl in the order listed on the entry form. Substitutes will be allowed. No changes may be made to an entry lineup when a substitute is added.
- 5) Handicap will be based on 100% of the difference in the bowler's average and 150.
- 6) Should a team not have two (2) members by the start of their scheduled time to bowl, a vacancy score of 80 will be used.
- 7) All food and drink **MUST** be kept out of the pit area. Parents are asked to make sure bowler's hands are clean and dry before their time to bowl.
- 8) The foul line and lights must be observed.
- 9) Only adults authorized by tournament director may be in the pit area. Parents, guardians and guests of tournament bowlers **MUST** sit behind the score table/pit area.
- 10) A bowler arriving late will begin play and the score will count beginning with the frame then bowled. Missed frames will be credited with a zero.
- 11) No score will be official until verified by the tournament officials. Any protest must be filed in writing with the tournament director within twenty-four (24) hours following the games(s) rolled.
- 12) Inappropriate behavior or non compliance with any rule while participating in the tournament will be considered grounds for disqualification.
- 13) Awards will be given to the first (1st) and second (2nd) place teams. Individual awards will be given for high game scratch, series scratch, game handicap, and series handicap to both girls and boys. No bowler may win more than one (1) individual award. High game takes precedence over series. Handicap awards take precedence over scratch.
- 14) Entries must be postmarked by November 7, 2014. Entry forms must be accompanied by money order, cashier's check, bowling center or corporate check made payable to “**Memphis Area USBC**”. No personal checks or cash will be accepted. No fees will be refunded after being received by the tournament director. All returned checks will be subject to a \$35.00 return check fee.
- 15) Dates and times will be scheduled in the order entries are received by the tournament director.
- 16) No electronic devices may be used by bowlers while bowling in this tournament.
- 17) Entry **MUST** be completely filled out or entry will be placed at bottom of list until information is received.
- 18) **Rules not covered will be decided by the Tournament Committee or USBC rules governing tournament play. Decisions by the tournament manager are final.**
- 19) Entry Fee Breakdown: Lineage (Bowling) \$4.50 – Awards \$4.50 = \$9.00 (Per person)
